WHEELCHAIR & PUSHCHAIR USERS

Warwick Castle was built as a mediaeval fortress and, as such, it has a large number of steps and narrow doorways which present limitations for guests who use a wheelchair or have a pushchair.

Please ask at our entrance for a helpful guide on getting around the Castle, otherwise please ask any member of staff for further assistance.

CASTLE DUNGEON

Due to its scary content the Castle Dungeon may not be suitable for children under the age of 10. All children aged under 18 must be accompanied by a person aged 18 or over. School groups must be accompanied by a teacher or group leader.

Please note that due to the nature of the Castle Dungeon, pre-walking children and babes in arms are not permitted into this attraction.

USEFUL INFORMATION

The Towers & Ramparts walk contains up to 530 steps and is one way only. Visitors who are elderly, infirm or who have a heart condition are advised not to take the walk. Guests will exit the Towers and Ramparts at the Kingmaker entrance.

BABY FEEDING

A baby feeding area is available in the Undercroft restaurant, please ask a member of our restaurant team for assistance.

SMOKING

Guests are permitted to smoke in outside areas excluding the Central Courtyard and Stables Courtyard. For the comfort of our guests please refrain from smoking in queue lines or at any of our shows.
